- NOTICE TO UDX or RAE Class Entrants: those wishing to enter these classes only if their entries are accepted for BOTH Open B/Utility B for obedience or BOTH Advanced B/Excellent B for rally should write a note on the entry form.
- Telegraph, Telephone, FAX, E-mailed and Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- Recording fees will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or Member Club show. Obedience Trial, Rally Trial, or Tracking Test. This fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club.
- There will be an AKC Service Fee of \$3.00 and an AKC recording fee of \$0.50 per entry in the Obedience Trial. There will be an AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 per entry in the Rally Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class, the fee is collected on all classes the dog is entered in.
- Entries Cannot Be Accepted, Canceled, Altered or Substituted after the entries have closed. (See exception on Move-ups.)
- No entry will be accepted which carries any conditions regarding its acceptance.
- Declination of Entries. The Muncie Obedience Training Club, Inc., may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Muncie Obedience Training Club, Inc. or any official thereof.
- Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
- Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The TRIAL SECRETARY will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, in season, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of MOTC, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund or entry fee will be made. MOTC will not be responsible for loss or damage to property while on show site.
- Judges Are Not Required to Wait for Dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.
- Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at owner's expense.
- All Handlers Must Pick Up After Their Dogs. Anyone witnessed not cleaning up after their dogs will be requested to leave and no refunds given.
- The show site will open one hour prior to the start of the event and will close one hour after the event.
- There will be lunch and beverages available at the Show Site for purchase.
- All dogs must be kept on leash or crated at all times, except as allowed in the Show ring. NO FLEXI LEADS allowed inside the building.
- No smoking in buildings or school grounds.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, and any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

From NORTHWEST -- I-69 exit SR 332 East (Exit 41). From ramp, travel 3 1/3 miles, then turn South (right) at 600 W (there will be a small green sign that says Yorktown). Continue until "T," then turn left and take the next right (Tiger Drive). Continue past the high school and tennis courts to Yorktown Middle School.

From SOUTHWEST -- I-69 exit SR 67 (to 32) (Exit 34). The first road off the exit is SR 67; continue straight past SR 67 traffic light, road curves right, and at stop sign, turn left (East). Continue 6 miles to Yorktown. 2nd traffic light is Tiger Drive (to the North). Turn left and first drive on the right is Yorktown Middle School.

From NORTHEAST or SOUTHEAST - Join the SR 67/35/3 Bypass east of Muncie, take the SR 32 West exit. Note that SR 32 is Jackson Street in Muncie, then becomes Kilgore, then becomes Smith Street in Yorktown.

From MUNCIE MOTEL AREA -- Go West on McGalliard Road (becomes Hwy 332) to 400 W (just after Meijer Store). Turn left (South) on 400 W (also called Nebo Rd.) and continue to Kilgore/Hwy 32. Turn right and continue 1 1/7 miles to Tiger Drive. Turn right and first drive on right is Yorktown Middle School.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury, or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

I (we) agree that any cause of action, controversy or claim arising out of or related to the entry, exhibition or attendance at the event between the AKC and the event-giving club (unless otherwise stated in its premium list) and myself (ourselves) or as to the construction, interpretation and effect of this Agreement shall be settled by arbitration pursuant to the applicable rules of the American Arbitration Association.
