An online payment link will be sent within 24 hours of receipt of entry and payment is expected to be made within 24 hours of receiving the link for your entry to be accepted into the trial. There is a service fee for online payments. Be sure to check your SPAM folder, if MOTCbarkmailTS@gmail.com is not in your contacts list.

Incorrect payments may result in non-acceptance of the entry.

Illegible entry forms may result in non-acceptance of the entry.

Please remember that each event number/day represents a separate trial.

CHECKS WILL BE DEPOSITED AFTER CLOSING DATE

All refunds will be mailed after the trial has ended. Online payments can only be refunded back to the original form of payment, minus the service fee. Overpayments of \$5 or less will be considered a donation to MOTC. Returned checks will result in a \$35 fee being charged to the party responsible, for whom future entries will not be accepted until this transaction has been settled.

MOVE UPS will be allowed, if requested in writing and presented to the trial secretary before the day of the trial. There will be **NO** "Day Of" transfers. Move-ups will be approved provided the judge is available and the next level class has not reached its limit.

REFUNDS – There will be NO refunds for absent entries. Refunds will be made for withdrawn entries only if request is made prior to the closing date. Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. Refunds will be made for bitches in season (minus \$5 administrative fee per trial) if the trial secretary is notified no later than one half hour prior to the first class in the trial.

AWARDS

All awards will be given at the Trial. Exhibitors must remain for presentation if eligible for special prizes. In no case will prizes or trophies be mailed. All trophies or prizes must be claimed the day of the trial, or they will become the property of the Muncie Obedience Training Club.

In case of tie scores for any prize other than those listed under individual classes, a run-off will occur.

Where there is a double entry of the same dog, only one score will be used for the Special Awards.

Awards can be substituted at the discretion of the Muncie Obedience Training Club, based on availability.

CLASS RIBBONS AND PRIZES

Teams will receive a green qualifying ribbon for each dog receiving a Qualifying Score.

ENTRIES

It is highly recommended that exhibitors use Oakline Express to send in entries (www.oaklines.com/ExpressEntries). This is a free service that will securely store your dog's information for future trial entries and create a pdf that can be printed and mailed to prevent mistakes/misread information that could cause a delay in your entry being accepted.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – PLEASE READ

- Telegraph, telephone, FAX, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted, unless otherwise specified.
 - Entries not on official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE
 - Entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted after the entries have closed (see exception on Move-Ups)
 - No entry will be accepted which carries any conditions regarding its acceptance
 - Declination of Entries: The Muncie Obedience Training Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Muncie Obedience Training Club or any official thereof
 - Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date
 - Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The TRIAL SECRETARY will add a collection fee of \$35.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis
 - If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of MOTC, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
 - Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.
 - Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at owner's expense.
 - All handlers must pick up after their dogs. Anyone witnessed not cleaning up after their dogs will be requested to leave and no refunds will be given.
 - NO FLEXI LEADS OR TRAINING COLLARS (prong or electronic) allowed on the grounds.
 - No smoking in the building or within 10 ft of the building ("reasonable distance" per county code).
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DIRECTIONS TO MOTC SHOW SITE

From Interstate 69: I-69 exit SR 332 (Exit 241). Highway 332 turns into McGalliard Road. Continue through town to Walnut Street. Turn right (south) onto Walnut Street. Turn left (east) at the first light (Centennial Ave). The building is on the north side of the street, there is a sign just outside the building on the street.

CRATING

Exhibitors must bring a waterproof tarp or blanket to place under your chair and crate.

*Inside crating is available. If a crate is present, dogs must be in the crate, unless showing or warming up to show. A warm up area will be separated out. Please do **NOT** warm up in the hall leading to the Café.*

INSTRUCTIONS

(Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering, i.e. A or B.

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3 of *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.)

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary, and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury, or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death, or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATION, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**
